I have a very special announcement! The Fuller Society will be placing a Fuller memorial gravestone in the historic Nemasket Hill Cemetery, Middleborough, MA in memory of our Fuller ancestors.

The stone will be in memory of the Fullers that came on the Mayflower as well as Edward's son, Matthew. There are no known existing gravestones for any of these Fullers. It is thought that Edward's sons, Samuel and Matthew, are buried in Barnstable, however the exact locations are unknown. A dedication ceremony for the memorial stone has been planned for 20 September 2020 at the cemetery. This ceremony will kick off our 2020 Annual Meeting which will be held in Scituate, MA.
